- Beloit took its second straight from playoff-bound Peoria, 3-1 on Friday night at Dozer Park.
- The Sky Carp scored early, as Cam Barstad doubled to bring Jorge Caballero in from first in the second inning.
- Peoria tied the game at one in the third, scoring on an error from Beloit second baseman Ryan Ignoffo.
- The unearned run is the only damage Sky Carp starter Cade Gibson would allow, as the southpaw fired six innings, striking out seven.
- Beloit regained the lead for good in the fifth with an Osiris Johnson RBI single.
- Edgar Sanchez worked out of a bases loaded jam to preserve the lead in the seventh.
- Torin Montgomery provided some insurance in the ninth inning with a pinch-hit RBI single before Cristian Charle finished a 2-inning save in the bottom half of the frame.

STRONG STAFF SHOWING

Beloit's pitching staff has allowed just seven earned runs in four games this week in Peoria, pitching to an 0.86 WHIP. Last night, the Sky Carp did not allow an earned run in their 3-1 victory. It was Beloit's first game without allowing an earned run since they shut out Quad Cities 11-0 on August 16th. The Sky Carp have surrendered just seven hits in the last two games.

BULLISH ON THE 'PEN

Sky Carp relievers have been strong in the first four games of the series with Peoria this week, firing 13.2 shutout frames. It's a strong bounce back from Beloit's sweep at the hands of Wisconsin, when the bullpen allowed 20 earned runs in 27.1 innings (6.59 ERA).

HIP, HIP, JORGE!

In two games this series, Beloit outfielder Jorge Caballero is 6-8 with four doubles. With his big pair of games, Caballero has boosted his batting average from .221 to .261 - his highest mark since August 6th.

SEARCHING FOR SERIES SUCCESS

With a win tonight or Sunday, the Sky Carp would clinch their first series victory in their last 10 sets (5 losses, 4 splits). Beloit's last series win came when it took five of six from South Bend June 28 through July 3. Beloit went 3-9 against Peoria in the teams' first two series.

IN A PINCH?

Torin Montgomery continued Beloit's pinch hit success with his ninth inning RBI single last night. Sky Carp hitters are an incredible 14-41 (.341) in pinch hit spots this season with 12 RBIs. West Michigan (.357) is the only team with a higher average. The Midwest League's average in pinch hit situations is .252.

IN THE TOOL BOX

On Tuesday, Baseball America released its "Best Tools" lists for High-A leagues, which are voted on by league managers. Marlins No. 8 prospect Yiddi Cappe was selected to have the "Best Infield Arm."

IT'S NOT MEANT TO BE WHEN THE CARP SCORE THREE (OR FEWER)

Beloit is 5-56 when scoring three runs or fewer this season after winning 3-1 last night. On the other hand, when Beloit tallies six or more runs, their record is 32-4.

IN THE ALMANAC

Beloit has clinched its most losses in a season since joining the Marlins organization prior to the 2021 season with 75. Beloit has never finished with fewer than 54 wins since at least 1995. Beloit's worst record in recent memory came in 2019, when the Snappers finished 54-84 in their final season as an Oakland affiliate.

OFFENSIVE OUTAGE

The Sky Carp offense has sputtered down the stretch, averaging 3.5 runs and 7.3 hits per game in their last 31 contests. The team has been shutout six times in that span. In the first 36 games of the second half, Beloit averaged 5.3 runs per game and 9.3 hits and suffered one shutout loss.

LANGUISHING WITH THE BASES LOADED

Across Beloit's last 17 games, the team has gone 0-18 with 10 strikeouts in bases loaded situations.

- Made his pro debut with A-Jupiter on 9/9/22 - skipped over rookie ball.
- Helped Liberty High School to a Missouri State Championship in 2021.
- Was a strong football player and all-district basketball player in High School... played wide receiver on the gridiron and also kicked.
- Was not a pitcher until his freshman year of high school.
